**Subject: Call for Nominations: Chancellor's Awards for Excellence and the SUNY Shared Governance Award for Academic Years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024**

I am pleased to issue the call for nominations for the Chancellor's Awards for Excellence and the SUNY Shared Governance Award. Brief program summaries as well as links to the full guidance documents for each program are provided below for academic years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024. Only email submissions are accepted.

**1. Call for Nominations for the Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Adjunct Teaching for academic years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.**

This Chancellor's Award for Excellence recognize the expertise, commitment, and dedication of SUNY's adjunct faculty who serve as exemplars for their peers. The program *Policies and Procedures*, including the number of nominations allowed per campus, are posted [online](#). We encourage campuses to have a diverse and inclusive pool of candidates for consideration. The deadline for receipt of nominations is **Tuesday, November 8, 2022** for academic year 2022-2023, and **Tuesday, November 14, 2023** for academic year 2023-2024. Please submit nominations electronically to [excellenceawards@suny.edu](mailto:excellenceawards@suny.edu). Award announcements are made annually in mid/late February.

**2. Call for Nominations for the Chancellor's Awards for Excellence in Faculty Service, Librarianship, Professional Service, Scholarship and Creative Activities, and Teaching for academic years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.**

These Chancellor's Awards for Excellence recognize the expertise, commitment, and dedication of SUNY's diverse body of faculty and professional staff. Full-time tenured or tenure track faculty and full-time non-tenure track faculty, including those who hold the title of full-time Lecturer, are eligible for nomination in three categories: Faculty Service, Scholarship and Creative Activities, and Teaching. The complete program *Policies and Procedures* for these awards, including the number of nominations allowed per campus, are posted [online](#). Again, we encourage campuses to have a diverse and inclusive pool of candidates for consideration. The deadline for receipt of nominations is **Tuesday, February 21, 2023** for academic year 2022-2023, and **Tuesday, February 20, 2024** for academic year 2023-2024. Please submit nominations electronically to [excellenceawards@suny.edu](mailto:excellenceawards@suny.edu). Award announcements are made annually in late April.

**3. Call for Nominations for the SUNY Shared Governance Award for academic years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.**

In support of SUNY's ongoing commitment to shared governance, the SUNY Shared Governance Award is a System-level honor recognizing outstanding and sustained contributions to the advancement of shared governance. One campus each year may be selected for this award, and all SUNY campuses may self-nominate. **Note: Previous recipients in this category may not apply again in any of the following five academic years.** Please see the program *Policies and Procedures* [online](#) for additional details. The deadline for receipt of nominations is **Tuesday, November 15, 2022** for academic year 2022-2023, and **Tuesday, November 21, 2023** for academic year 2023-2024. Please submit nominations electronically to [awards@suny.edu](mailto:awards@suny.edu). The Award announcement is typically made no later than the third week of March.
