#### Reporting group meeting debrief and discussion

The reporting group is likely to recommend folding micro-credentials into the SIRIS degree submission

It was mentioned that there is currently not a specifically designed table in the SIS's to store microcredential information

This would create the need for custom tables in the Banner SIS's and the non-Banner campuses would need programming assistance accordingly

UB may be working with Peoplesoft to create a micro-credential location

If the information is stored in the SIS perhaps the transcript servicing providers could create an addendum to the academic transcript for micro-credentials

There was also discussion regarding what specific information was permissible on the academic transcript

This branched into a discussion about local approval vs. needing NYSED approval

It was suggested that we reach out to admissions professionals to determine if they have a preference in where microcredential information is housed

There was discussion around which vendors to bring back for second demonstrations

Credly and Portfolium were the top two selected

The team identified follow up items for each vendor to provide or further demonstrate
