SUNY is currently designing 33 construction projects, including Stony Brook's NYSUNY2020 project, valued at \$931.3 million, that will create more than 7,400 jobs as well as maintain and improve upon existing facilities while serving local priorities as expressed by the Long Island Regional Economic Development Council.
