



Resolution in support of the Student Mobility Steering Committee

#ASA1: 2013-2014

Passed unanimously on October 19, 2013

Whereas the Memorandum of Understanding from the SUNY Office of the Provost dated December 21, 2010 establishes the Student Mobility Steering Committee, and

Whereas the charge of the Student Mobility Steering Committee is to “ make recommendations to the SUNY Provost on all matters concerning the ability of students to transfer from one campus to another within SUNY as prescribed by the SUNY Board of Trustees Policy,” and

Whereas the SUNY Board of Trustees Resolution 2012-089 on Seamless Transfer Requirements directly speaks to issues within the charge of the Student Mobility Steering Committee, and

Whereas the Student Mobility Steering Committee has met, discussed and made recommendations to the Office of the SUNY Provost on the aforementioned Board resolution; be it therefore

Resolved that the Faculty Council of Community Colleges supports the recommendations of the Student Mobility Steering Committee sent to the Interim Provost in a letter dated October 16, 2013 and be it further

Resolved that the Faculty Council of Community Colleges asks that while considering the recommendations made by the Student Mobility Steering Committee, the Office of the SUNY Provost provide a formal response in writing to each recommendation prior to policy or implementation decisions.
