Resolution on Chancellor's Award for Shared Governance

Resolution # A3:2011-2012

WHEREAS, the University Faculty Senate Programs and Awards Committee is proposing a new SUNY Chancellor's Award for Shared Governance as a system-level honor and recognition to be conferred on a campus(es) or project for outstanding contributions to the advancement of shared governance; and

WHEREAS, each campus will be eligible to submit one proposal per year that will be adjudicated by a system-wide selection committee comprised of members from the UFS, the Faculty Council of Community Colleges, and members of 4-year state operated campuses and community college administration; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines will be developed by the Programs and Awards Committee following the examples of existing awards publications;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FCCC endorses and supports the creation of a Shared Governance Award as proposed by the UFS Programs and Awards Committee.
