Resolution on Chancellor's Early Career Award

WHEREAS, the University Faculty Senate Programs and Awards Committee is proposing a new Chancellor's Early Career Award for Faculty and a new Chancellor's Early Career Award for Professional Staff to recognize emerging professional achievement and to encourage the continued pursuit of excellence; and

WHEREAS, nominees must have completed at least two—but not more than four—academic years of full-time employment; and

WHEREAS, the policies and procedures will be created by the UFS Programs and Awards Committee following the guidelines of existing awards;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Faculty Council of Community Colleges supports and endorses the creation and implementation of these awards.
