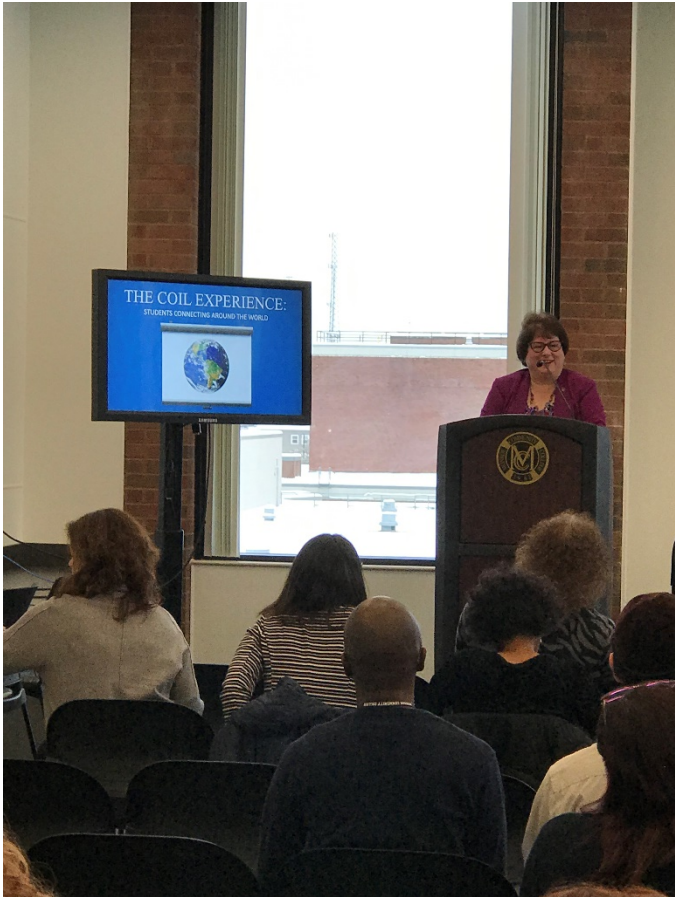

Shows the significant deforestation occurring in Rondonia between the years 2000 and 2013



About 15 percent of global greenhouse gases come from tropical deforestation - more than from all the world's cars, trucks, and buses combined. Considering the Amazon rainforest contains roughly one-third of the world's remaining tropical rainforest, it's paramount that these areas are protected and preserved.

In Rondonia, deforestation started as early as 1960 and has continued until the present. The forest continues to be cut down in this area to make room for industrial scale agriculture.

While deforestation has decreased drastically in the Amazon due to new laws put in place by the Brazilian government, areas like Rondonia are still being

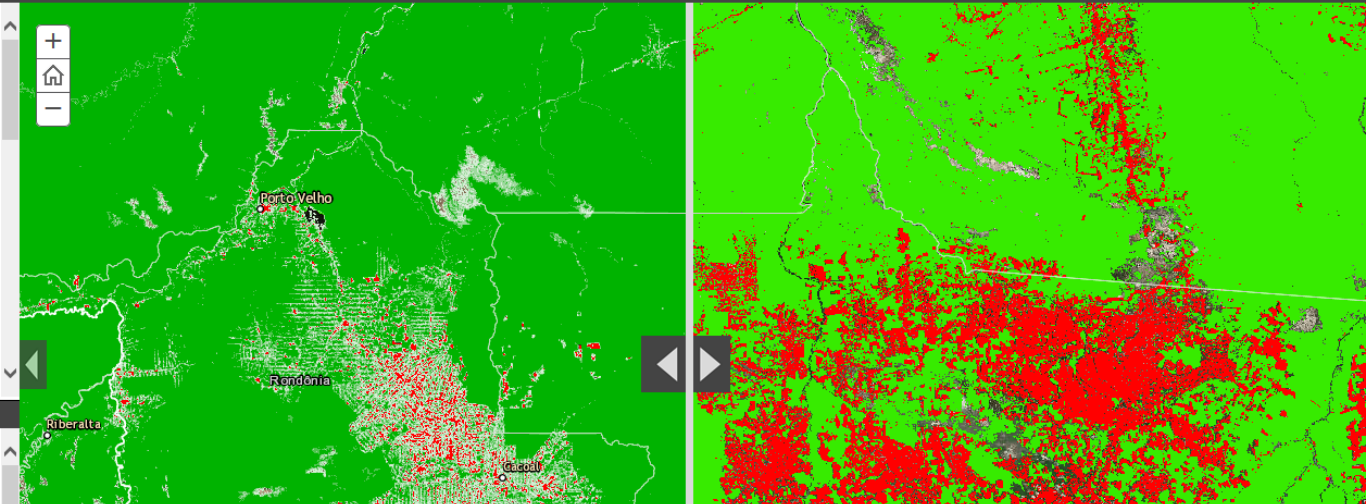
