Students work together to:

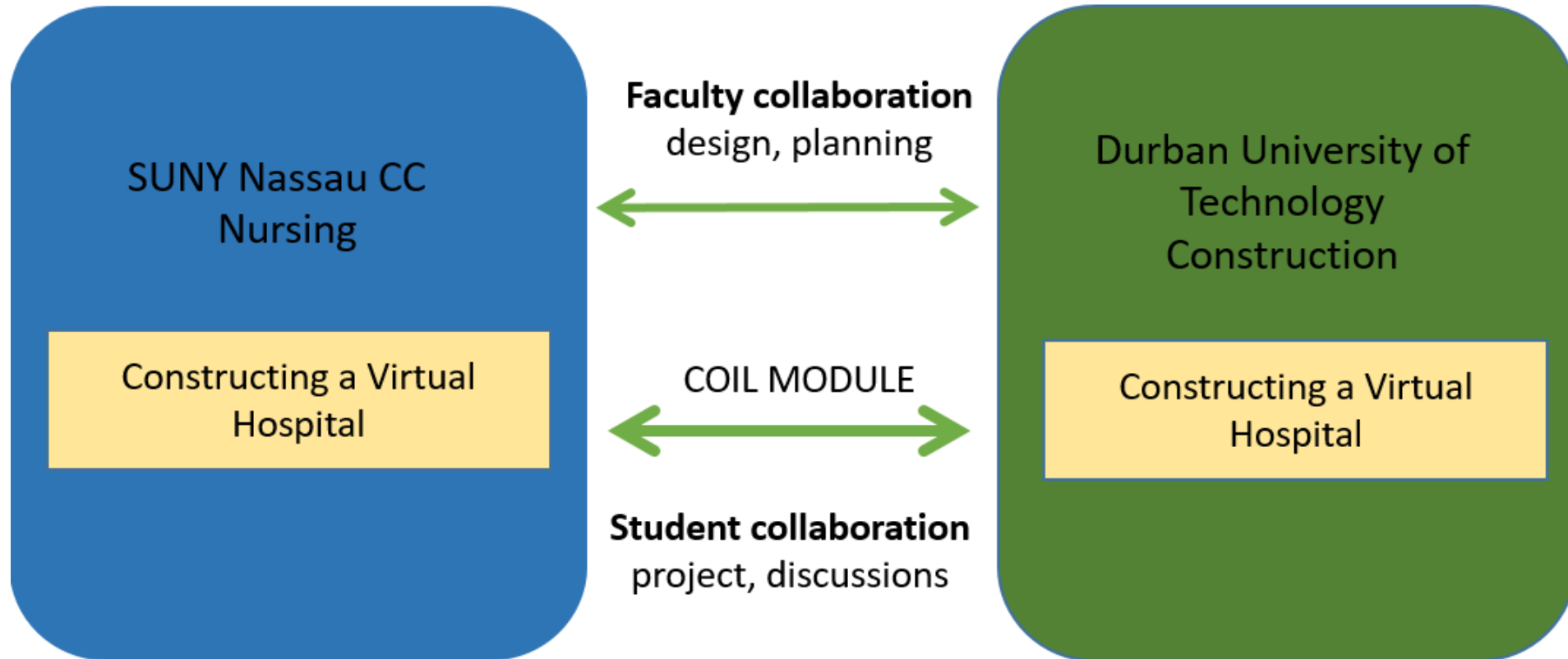
- Develop an effective international team
