



# Supporting Federal TRIO Programs

Federal TRIO funding consist of eight programs targeted to serve and assist low-income students, first-generation students, and students with disabilities as they navigate their higher education careers.

These programs provide outreach and student services to both identify these students and support them through their college career to completion. Without these services, students are often unable to utilize financial assistance offered by other federal Title IV financial aid programs.

- » Nationally, TRIO serves about 880,000 students through around 3,000 programs.
- » New York State receives \$34.2 million to administer Federal Trio Programs. These programs serve 19,579 students across the state.
- » SUNY institutions receive \$15.9 million to administer Federal TRIO Programs, which serve 9,300 students.
