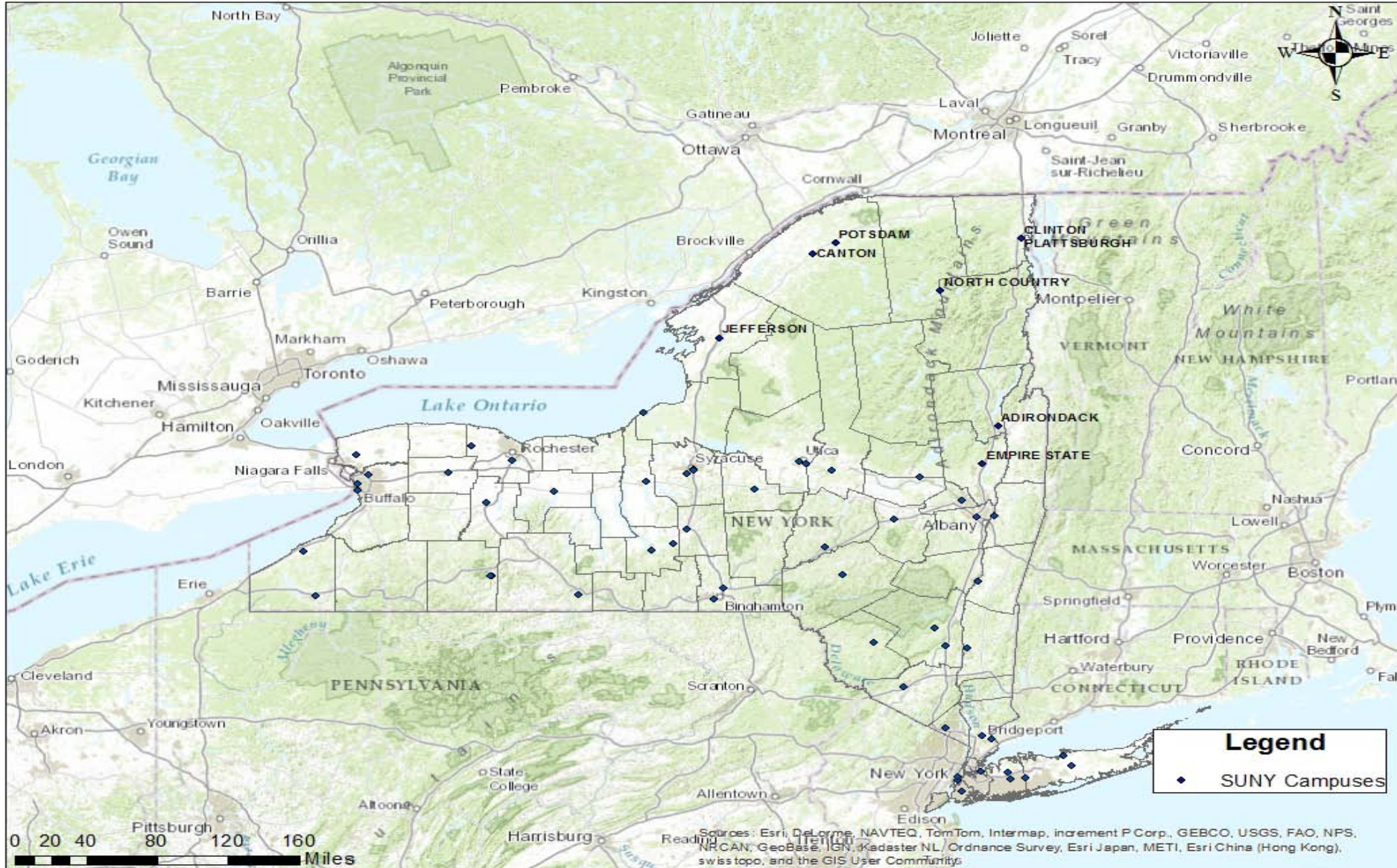

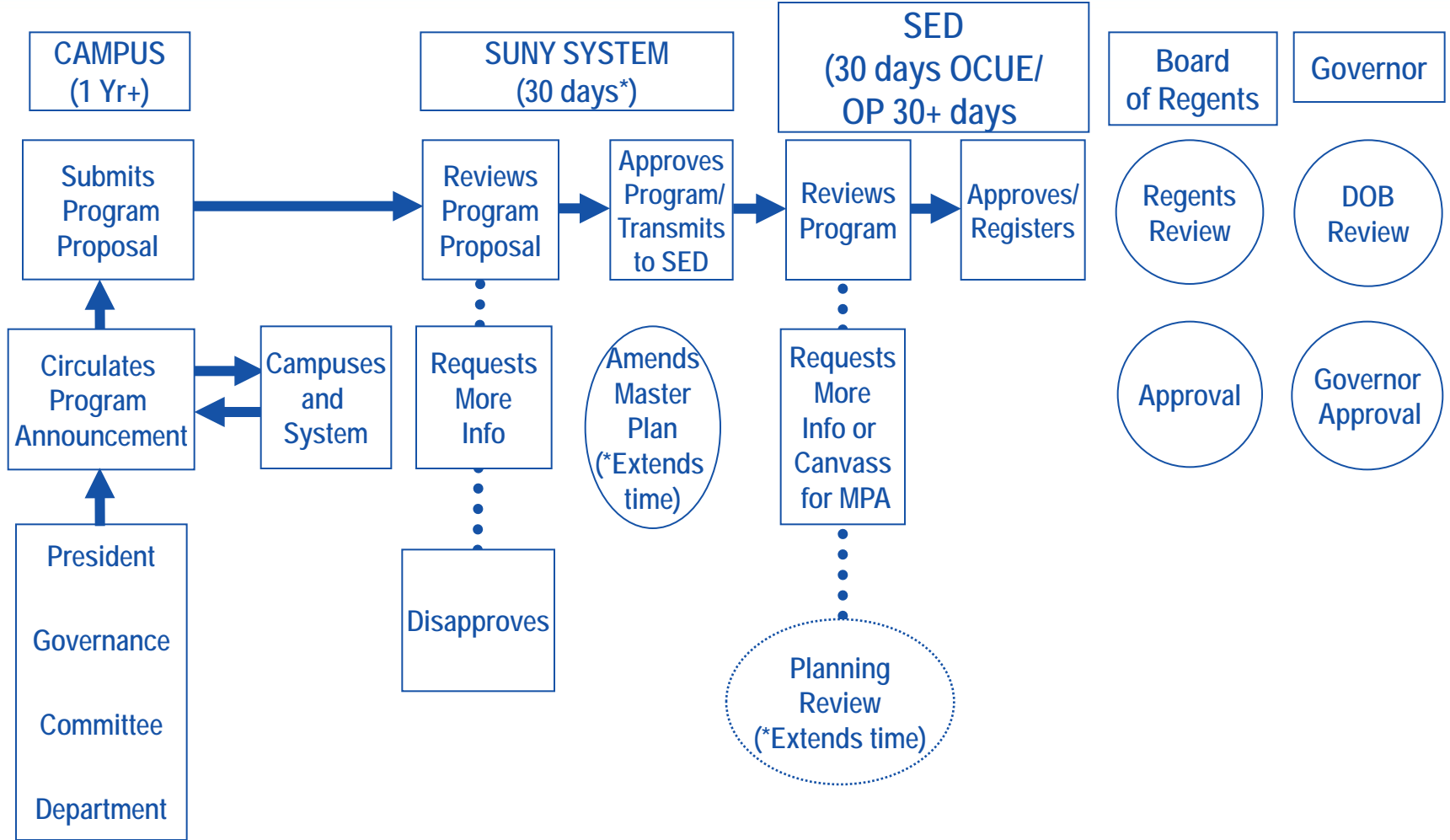

SUNY High Needs Grant Program

Transitional grant support to establish or expand programs that require significant resources to start-up, operate & expand and are in high needs occupation fields.

- **HEALTHCARE is one of the six statewide high needs areas in 2013-14.**

Results of SUNY High Needs Program for Healthcare

- **SUNY has produced nearly 700 more nursing degrees from 2007-2012.**
- **Enrollment in Nursing programs has increased by over 2,700 in Bachelor programs, 950 in Masters, and 185 in Doctoral programs from 2007-2012**
- **In 2013-14 Competitive RFP, 9 awards were made in Healthcare for a total of over \$2.7 million.**
- **Grants made for online Clinical & Histological Lab Techs, Nursing at all levels including online, Physical Therapy, Human Services & Chemical Dependency Counseling.**
