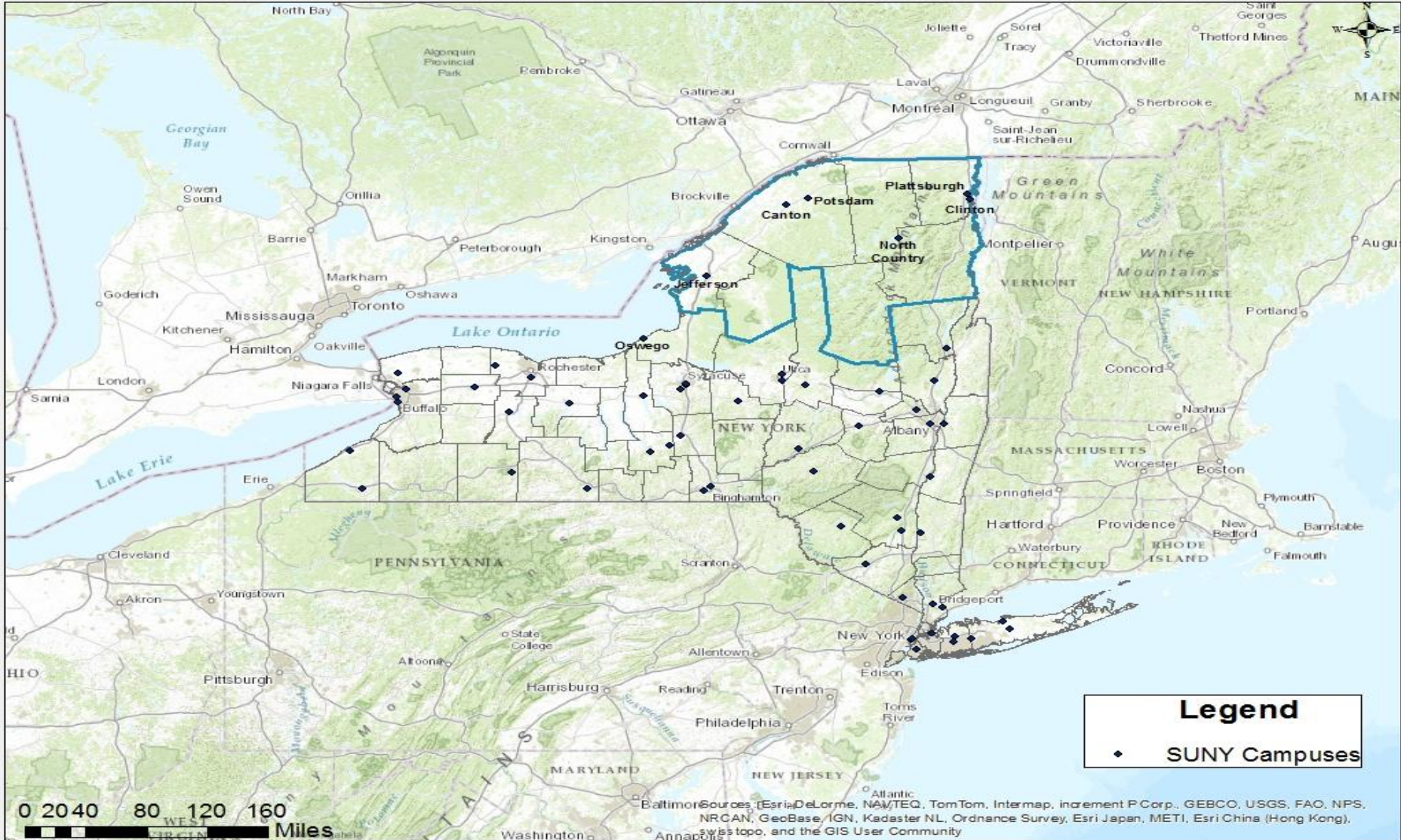

***Transitional grant support to establish or expand programs that require significant resources to start-up, operate & expand and are in high needs occupation fields.***

# Results of SUNY High Needs Program for Healthcare

- **SUNY is producing over 500 more nursing degrees in 2013 than it did in 2007.**
- **Enrollment in Nursing programs has increased by over 1400 in Bachelor programs, 320 in Masters, and 193 in Doctoral programs from 2007-2013.**
- **In 2013-14 Competitive RFP, 9 awards were made in Healthcare for a total of over \$2.7 million.**
- **Grants made for online Clinical & Histological Lab Techs, Nursing at all levels including online, Physical Therapy, Human Services & Chemical Dependency Counseling.**
